







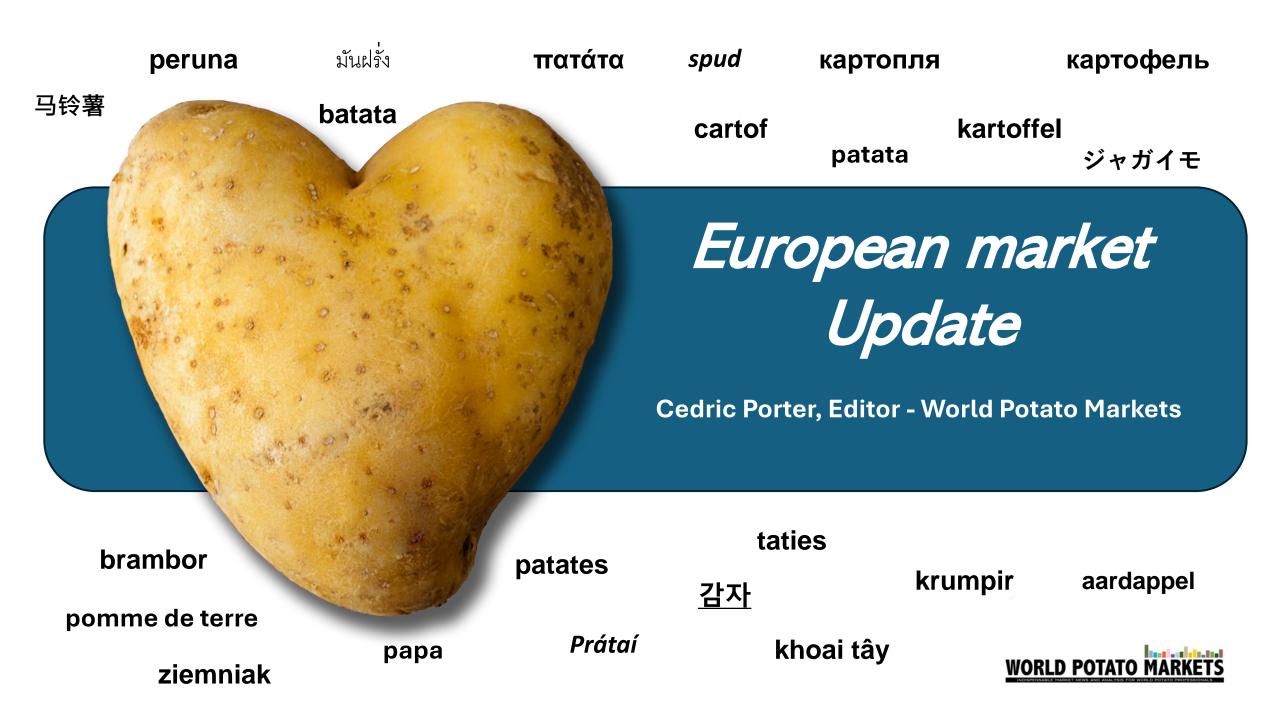

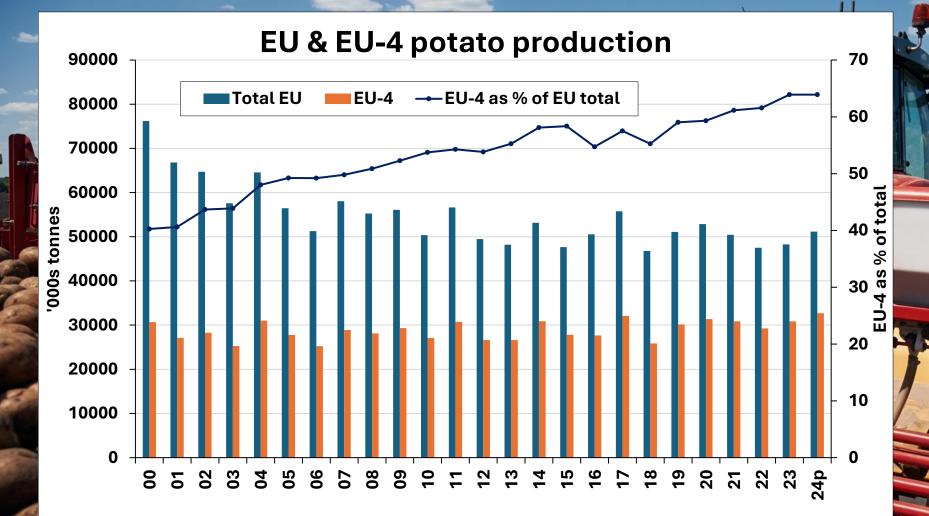

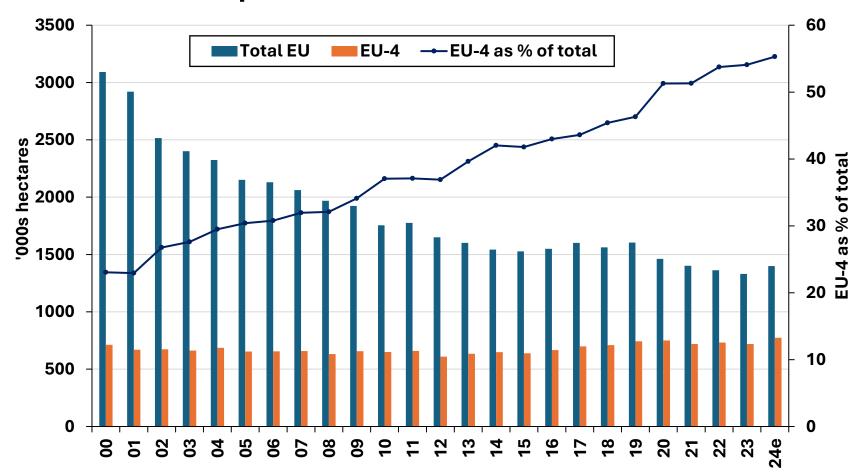


EU production is a little larger than last year but similar to 2021. Output in the EU-4 (Germany, France, Netherlands and Belgium) could be the largest ever and 2/3 of <u>E</u>U production

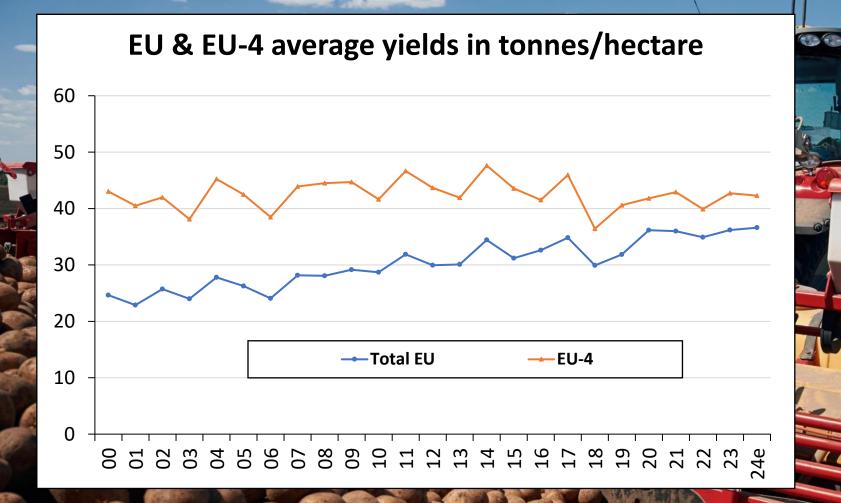
EU & EU-4 potato area. Source: Eurostat & WPM

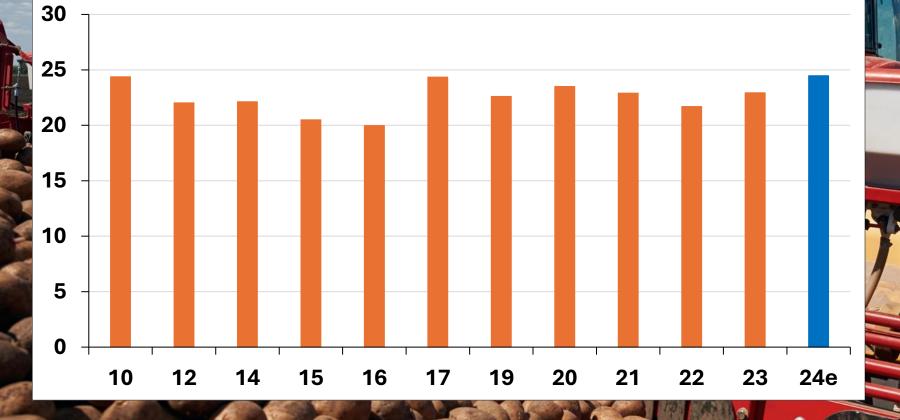


Average EU yields have been increasing but not in the EU-4. There has been a slowdown in yield development over the last five years.

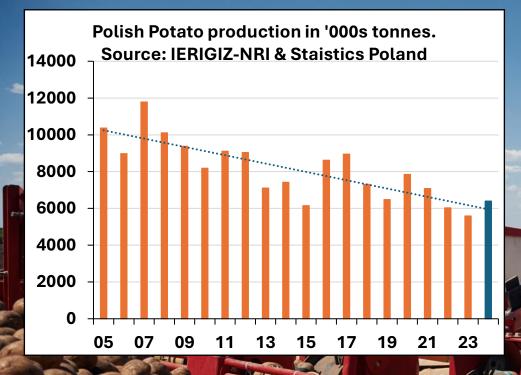
EU-4 potato production million tonnes. Calculations based on NEPG figures



The EU-4 have produced a record crop (only just)! France & Belgium had record crops and Germany its largest for 20 years. These countries account for 90%+ of the EU's potato exports

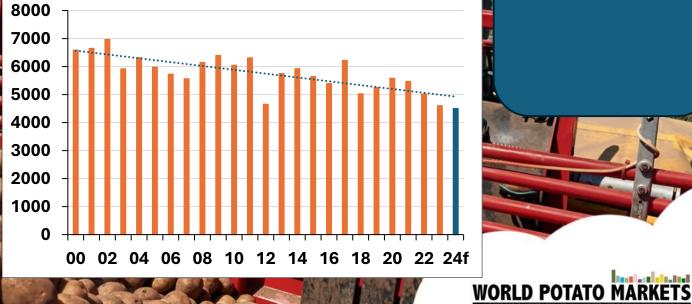

Production Poland recovered a little, but UK output was probably at a record low

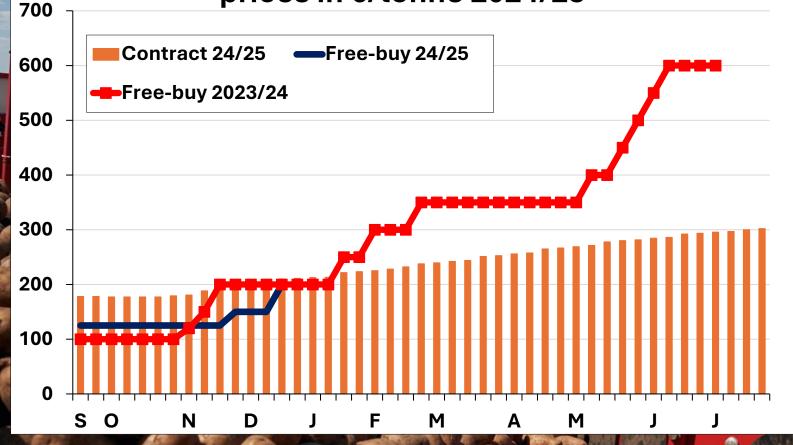

European potato growers have not experienced a 'normal' year for years. That has made people nervous of growing potatoes



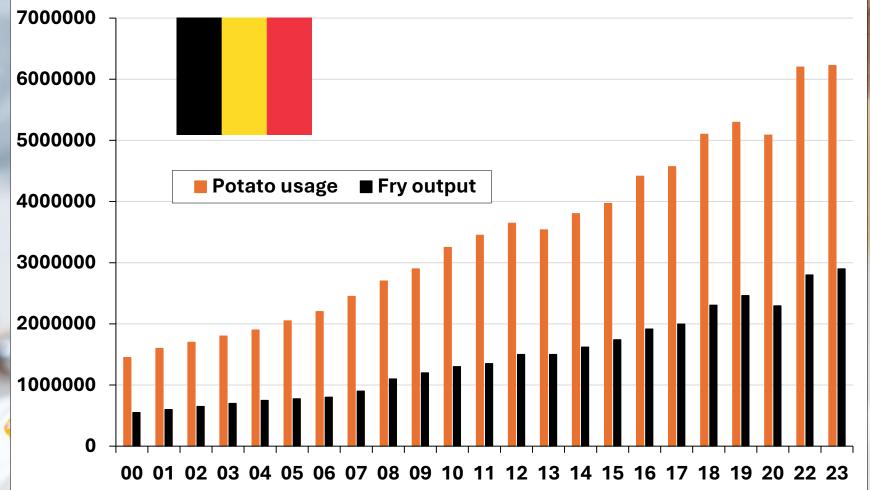
Belgapom Fontane free-buy and contract prices in €/tonne 2024/25



Potato prices are rising, perhaps a little slower than last season. Spot (free-buy) prices are similar to contract prices – 30% of processing potato sales are still spot. Contracts will probably stay still for 2025/26



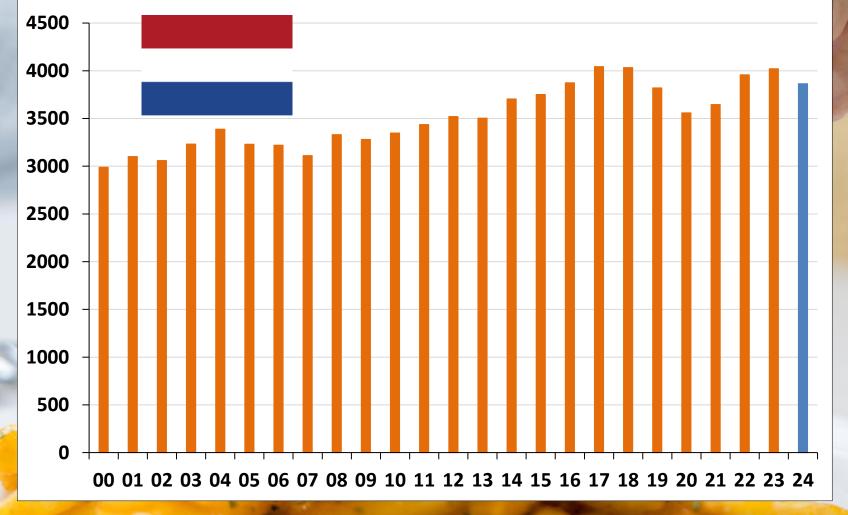
Belgian processing potato usage and fry output in tonnes. Source: Belgapom



The growth in Belgian processing production has been outstanding – up 425% since 2000. But it may have peaked



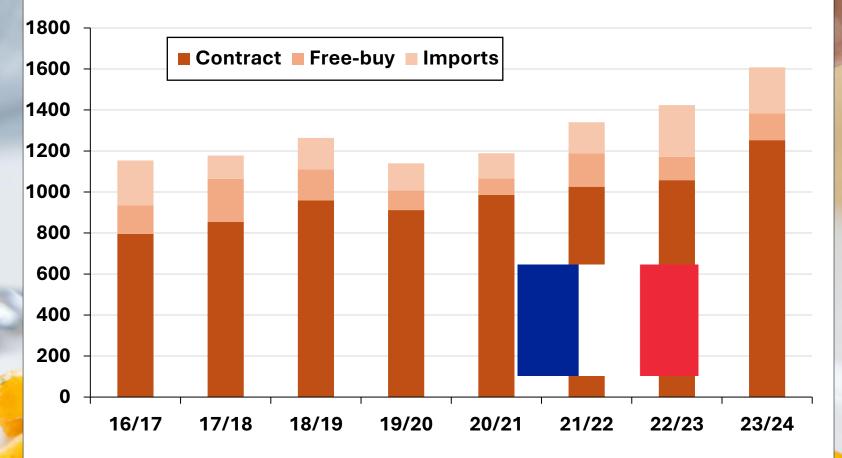
Annual Dutch processing potato usage in July to June seasons in '000s tonnes. Source: Vavi

The fry is coming home – but don't tell the Belgians! French processing output was up 18% in 2023/24 and 40% between in the previous seven years. It will be even higher in 2024/25.



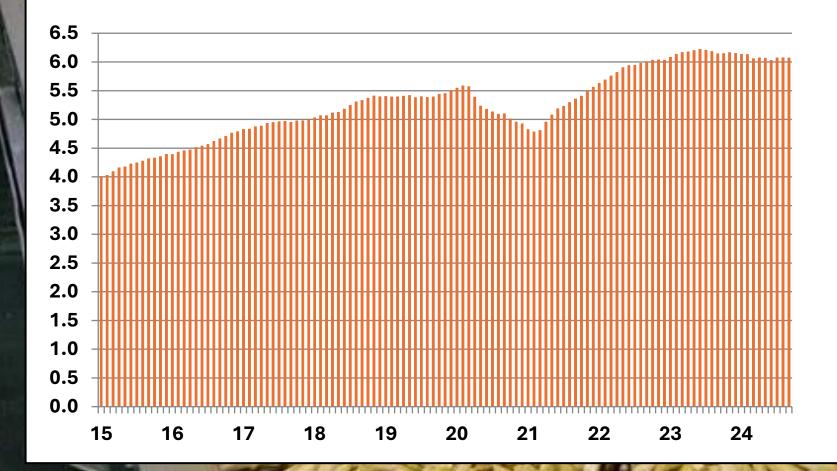


Someone has told the Belgians! Clarebout has built a plant just over the border in France. Agristo and Ecofrost are building others. Agristo has intentions of building US plants too. Meanwhile, McCain is investing US\$363 million to increase French output by 25%

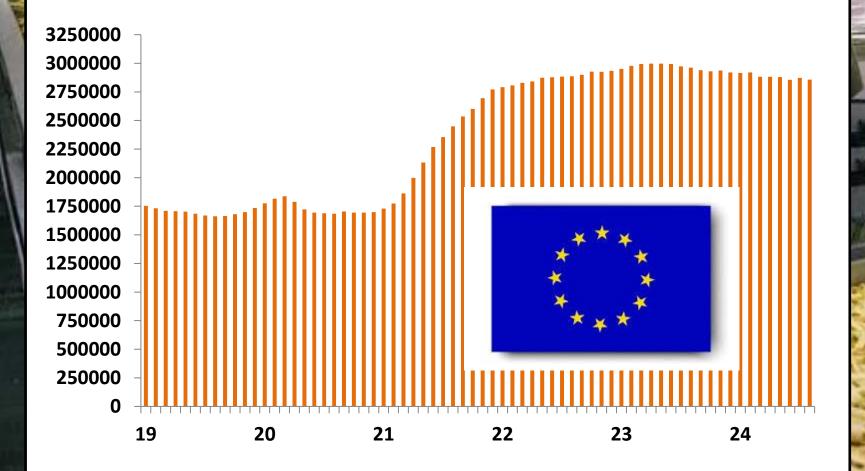




EU-5 fry exports (12-month periods (million tonnes)

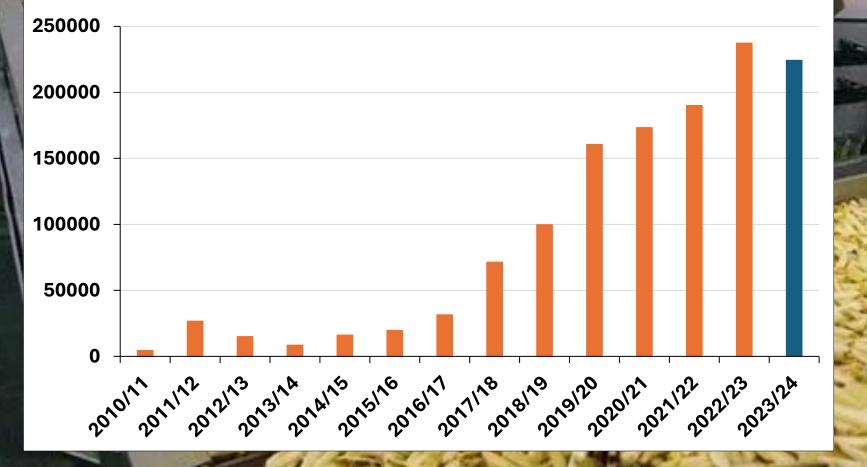


EU frozen fry exports bounced back strongly after Covid, but have come under pressure since. The EU-5 is Belgium, Netherlands, France, Germany & Poland EU-27 fry exports, 12-month periods (tonnes)



Crucially for you, sales outside the EU are under pressure

EU frozen fry exports to the US in tonnes



EU frozen fry exports to the US have peaked

There are some disrupter players

China fry exports. Years to September

India fry exports. Years to September

2018/19 **20,760** tonnes 2023/24 **171,000** tonnes (+723%)

2018 **18,000** tonnes 2023/24 189,000 tonnes (+1720%)

Increased processing capacity (especially in China) could mean further increases in exports

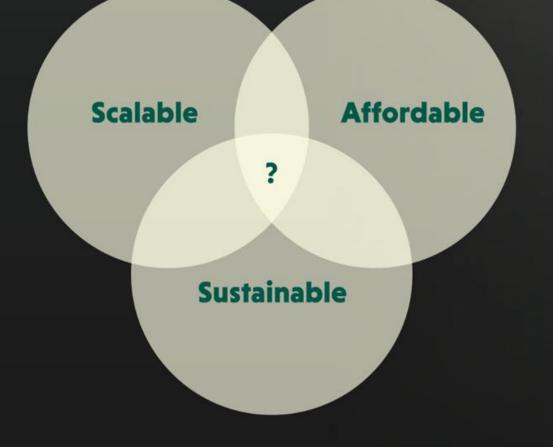

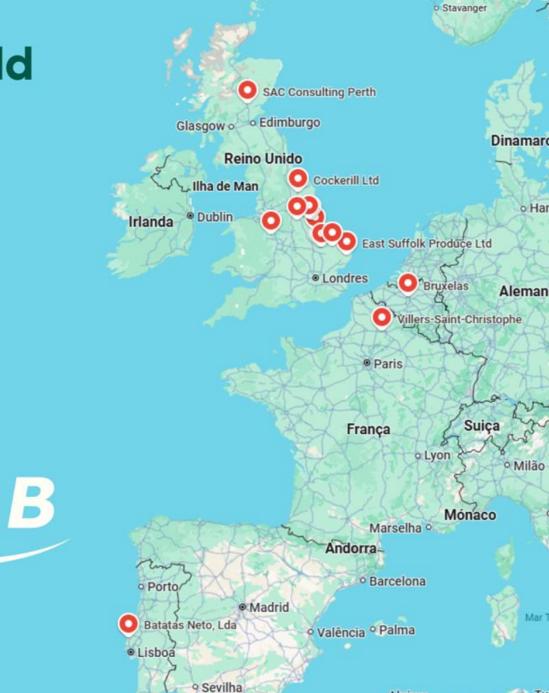
